



# Common Purpose Navigator

## Develop confidence and skills to meet the challenges of leadership

Common Purpose Navigator gives you the leadership kit you never expected. The course deals with real life issues and insights, so it is neither classroom nor lecture based. For example, we'll put you in prison, take you to a hospital or get you into a production plant. We go beyond standard leadership models and learn instead from the successes and failures of leaders from all sectors. Participants are taken out of their familiar environment to examine why, when and how they lead.

### WHO IS COMMON PURPOSE NAVIGATOR FOR?

People in the early stages of their career who already have some management responsibility. Participants are often grappling with questions like:

- What kind of leader am I?
- Do I have the ability to lead upwards and across departments in my organisation?
- Can I manage multiple stakeholders?
- Can I adapt to changing circumstances and surroundings?

### WHY SHOULD YOU TAKE PART?

The course helps you build the confidence, stamina and determination to meet complex challenges and lead with a global perspective. You will:

- learn to adapt and thrive in difficult and unfamiliar situations
- become more open to working with different people, in new ways, to solve complex problems
- develop lasting relationships that build trust and encourage collaboration
- be better able to take responsibility for issues outside your direct control.

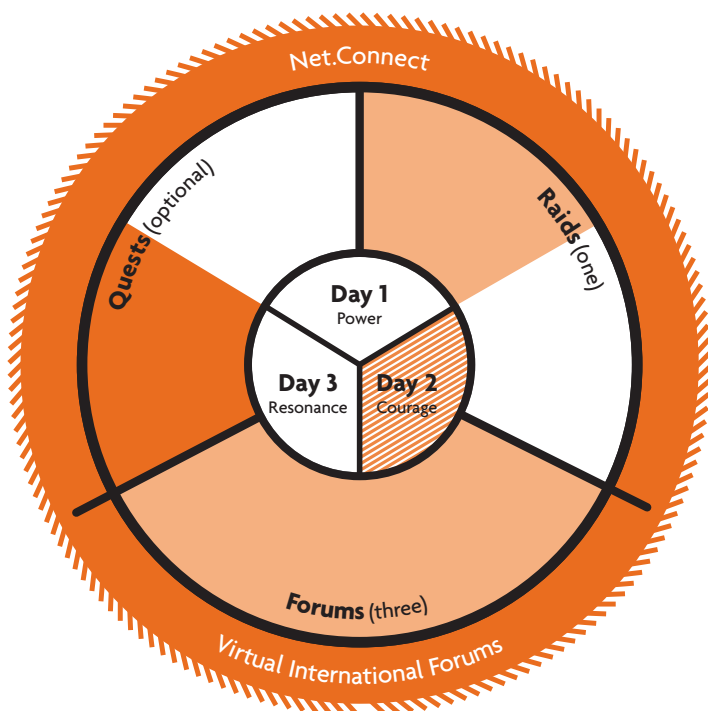
## WHAT HAPPENS ON THE COMMON PURPOSE NAVIGATOR COURSE?

You will take part in three core days with the whole group, where you will learn the role that power, courage and resonance play in effective leadership.

Learning from each other's ideas and experiences, you will explore leadership challenges in various workplaces, communities and internationally while examining your personal values and professional skills as a leader.

You are also able to choose from a menu of leadership modules to tailor your course:

- **Raids** – immerse yourself in a real-life change management challenge within a public, private or voluntary sector organisation.
- **Forums** - hear from leaders as they share with you their failures and successes, share your own leadership challenges and coach fellow participants by exploring and considering solutions to individual issues.
- **Quests** - explore social, economic, political and business leadership challenges in a different town, city or country. Quests are an optional part of the course.
- **Net.Connect** – link up with fellow participants online to offer, share and ask for advice and opportunities to gain exposure to each other's worlds.
